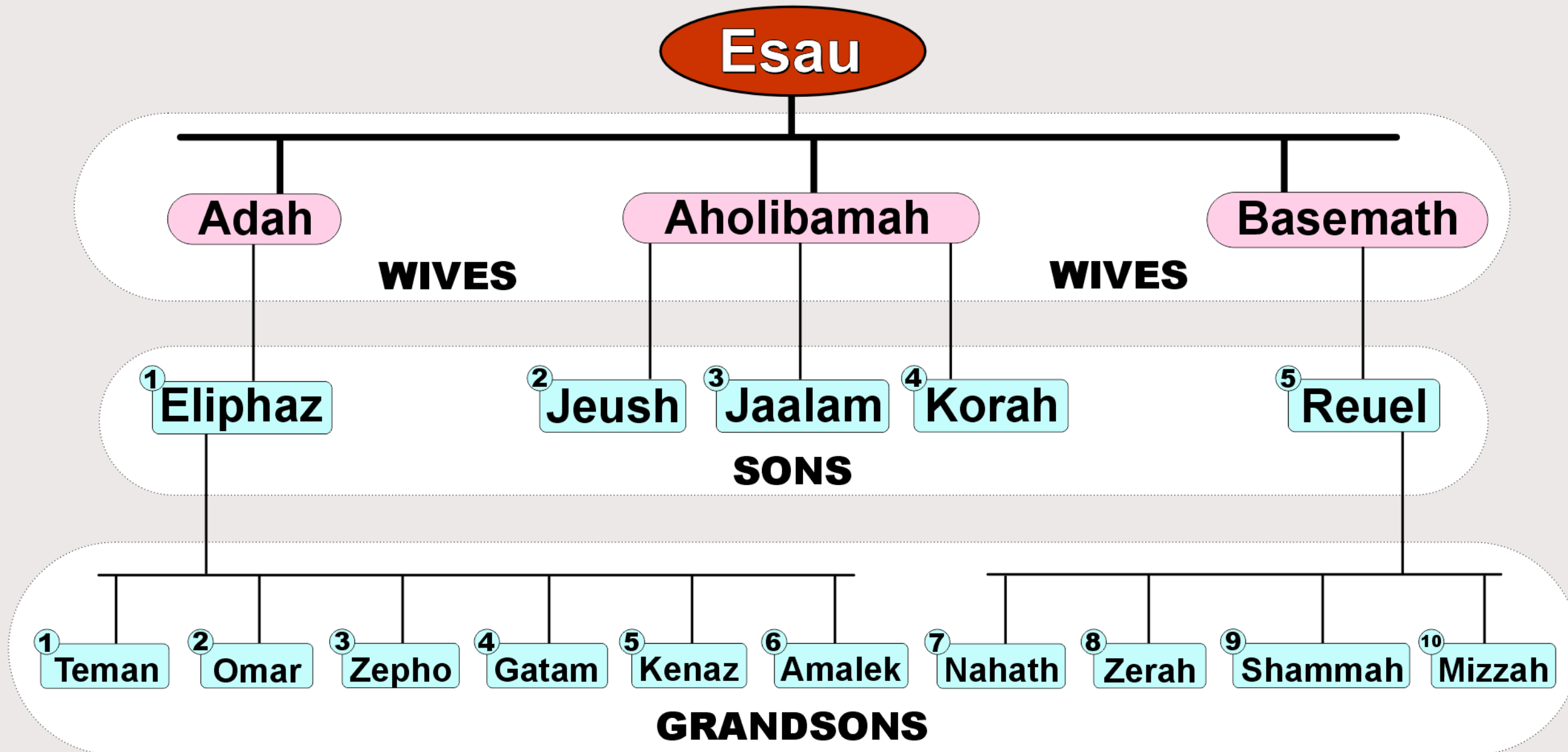


ESAU GENEALOGY — GENESIS 36



- The names of Esau's Canaanite wives are recorded earlier (Ge.26:34-35; 28:8; 36:2) and are different then they appear here. Moving to a new location may cause women to change their names. If they are conquered they may receive a new name (remember Daniel and friends).
- There is confusion in translation between the terms "Hittite," "Hivite," and "Horite." They seem to be the same people group that overlap.
- Esau's sons were born in the land (Canaan, Ge.36:5) before he moved to Seir (Ge.36:8). In contrast, Jacob's children were born (except for Benjamin) out of the land (Padan-aram, Ge.31:18; 33:18; 46:15), and who then moved into the land.
