

SYMBOL LEGEND — EZEKIEL 17

- The EAGLE symbolized **Nebuchadnezzar** (Ek.17:3,12)
- The LEBANON stood for **Jerusalem** or **land of Canaan** (Ek.17:3; Js.1:4; 2Ki.14:9)
- The CEDAR TREES were a figure of the **Davidic dynasty** (Ek.17:22; Is.10:33-11:1)
- The TOP OF CEDAR TREE is king **Jehoiachin**
- The TOPMOST YOUNG TWIG is **Jehoiachin's advisors** (2Ki.24:11-16)
- The LAND OF TRADE is **Babylon** (Ek.16:29; 17:4)
- The SEED are those whom Babylon **left behind in Judah** (Ek.17:5, 597BC)
- The ANOTHER GREAT EAGLE refers to **Egypt** (Ek.17:7,15, Pharaoh Apries)
- The VINE or SPREADING VINE refers to **Zedekiah** (Ek.17:6,14; 597-586 B.C.)
- The KING'S OFFSPRING is **Zedekiah** as a vassal subject (Ek.17:5,13)
- The TREES are **other nations** (Ek.17:24)
